To The Swedesboro Woolwich School Family,

The safety of our students, faculty, staff, and families remains one of our top priorities as a district. To that end, the following Covid-19 guidelines are in place for the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year and may be subject to change.

- Virtual instruction has been eliminated for students who choose to quarantine or isolate due to Covid-19. Students will be provided opportunities to make up work as they would for other illnesses. Many assignments will be accessible through Google Classroom.
- Contact tracing at school has been eliminated.
- There is no required testing for unvaccinated staff.
- The option for employees to work remotely due to Covid-19 illness has been eliminated.
- The [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention \(CDC\)](https://www.cdc.gov) has recommended that instead of quarantining if you were exposed to Covid-19, wear a high-quality mask for 10 days and get tested on day 5.
- Regardless of vaccination status, anyone testing positive for Covid-19 should isolate themselves:
  - If you test positive, stay home for at least 5 days from the day symptoms began and isolate yourself from others.
  - You should also isolate yourself if you are sick and suspect that you have COVID-19 but do not yet have test results.
  - If your results are positive, follow CDC's full isolation recommendations.
  - If your results are negative, you can end your isolation.
- Student absences are excused only when proof of a positive test and/or a physician's certificate is submitted to the attendance and/or nurse's office at the time of absence.
