of water goes into making just one cotton shirt;



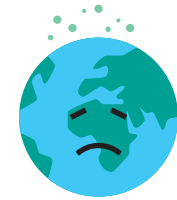

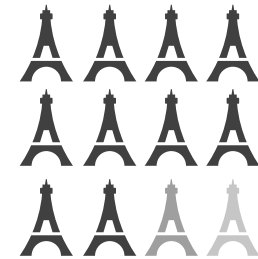
## 97 billion pounds
