Helene will create a Google Form to obtain 2020-2021 Board of Trustee Nominations and send out to the district through school messenger, Comet Clips and PTO FB page. Nomination due date will be May 17th. If school returns, election will be held at May Board meeting as usual. If school remains closed for the remainder of the year, electionrunner.com will be used to create online voting site for PTO members.
